under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of King
George the fourth to provide for the establishment of a Commission for
Tithes for a limited time in Ireland do fully approve of and
sanction the amicable agreement entered into between the
Rev. W. Lusk and the several vestry men ^{and churchwardens} of this
parish on the 31st day of August 1824 - and by which agree-
ment the Parsonages were to pay the Rev. W. Lusk
for the term of twenty one years the sum of Three Pounds
and pence annually as a Compensation for the vicarage
Tithes of said Parish - and ^{in full} ~~of which~~ ^{the} same he
agreed to accept of -
