

the Parishes of Drumkey & Kilpool  
were compounded for the annual  
sum of £1,150, since reduced  
under the Tithe Rent Charge  
Act to £863 : 10 : 0. the whole  
whereof was certified to be  
payable to the said Venerable  
Thomas Percival Magee, as Incumbent  
of said Union and Prebend. That  
the Tithe Rent Charge for the  
Parish of Drumkey which was  
not Prebendal amounted to the  
sum of £56 : 5 : 0 which was also  
certified to be payable to said  
Venerable Thomas Percival Magee as  
Incumbent of said Union of Wicklow.

That the Tithe Rent Charge for the  
Vicarage of Kilpool, which was  
not Prebendal, amounted to the  
sum of £45, which was also  
certified to be payable to the  
said Venerable Thomas Percival  
Magee as Incumbent of said  
Union of Wicklow, the Rectorial  
Tithes being certified to belong  
to the Earl Fitzwilliam - That  
in the year 1834 the said  
Venerable Thomas Percival  
Magee resigned the said Union  
of Wicklow retaining the Prebend  
as a sinecure to which two-  
thirds of the Tithe Rent Charge  
of
