That the said Prebend was now vacant by the death of the said Venerable Thomas Percival Magee - That it seemed to be desirable that the following Divisions and Appropriation of the Union & Prebend of Wicklow as then constituted should be made & His Grace the Lord Archbishop submitted the same for adoption to His Excellency the Lord Lieutenant and Privy Council as follows - that is to say.

That the Prebend of Wicklow & Parish of Rathnew including therein the Chapelry of Killoughter & Vicarage of Kilspoll and the Rectory & Vicarage of Drumkey & the following townlands in the Parish or Chapelry of Glanely - namely, Ballinabarney, Ballymerigan, Ballyleskin, Brolbeg
