sioners duly appointed and sworn under and by a virtue of
an Act of the fourth year of the King entitled "an Act to
provide for establishing Composition for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Com-
position for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable
within the Parish of Newcastle in the County of Waterford
and Diocese of Lismore, do hereby certify that the true and just
amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish is One hundred and fifty Pounds Sterling by the year, of
which sum of One hundred and fifty Pounds, Ninety Pounds
are due and payable for the Improvements Tithes thereof to the
Corporation of Waterford or their Lessees Will^m Powers Dan Donohue
and Ch^{rs} Bancroft, and Sixty Pounds thereof are due and
payable to the Rev. Usher Lee for the Tithes claimable by him as
Vicar of said Parish, And We further certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in said County
for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November
1821 is fourteen Shillings and one farthing per Barrel, dated
this 26th December 1827.
