

We Charles Rely and Richard Ryan Commissioners duly
appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an
act made in the fourth year of the reign of King
George the fourth intituled "An act to provide for
the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland
for a limited time" to ascertain and give a true and
just amount of composition for all tithes arising, growing,
yielded or payable within the parish of Newtown in the
County of Meath, do hereby certify, that the true and
just amount of composition for all tithes whatever
within the said parish is sixty six by the year of
which sum of sixty six pounds, the whole is due and
payable to the Reverend Wentworth Shield as a composition
for the tithes claimable by him as rector of the said
parish — and we do further certify that the average
price of wheat being the corn principally grown in
said County for a period of seven years ending on the first
day of November 1821 is one pound eighteen shillings and
eight pence half penny late Irish currency, per Barrel
