intituled An Act to provide for the Establishing of Composition
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited Time, to ascertain and fix a
true and just Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded
or payable within the Parish of Newtown Blonbun in the County
of Meath do hereby certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is
Fifty Pounds by the Year of which sum of Fifty Pounds the
whole is due and payable to the Rev^d Rich^d Butler as a
Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector of
the said Parish

And we do further certify the average Price of Wheat,
& Oats, the corn principally grown in said Parish, for the period
of Seven Years ending on the 24 Day of
October 1825 is Shillings per
