Establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, To Ascertain and fix a true and just  
Composition for all Tythes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of  
Naughaval in the Diocess of Killmore and County of Clare, do hereby Certify that the true  
and just Account of Composition for all Tythes whatever within the said Parish is  
Thirty five pounds Sterling British by the Year and that the said Sum of thirty five  
pounds Sterling is due and payable to the Rev Henry Allen as a Composition for the  
Tythe claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish of Naughaval, And We  
do further Certify that the said Compositions do continue Unvaried for the term of Twenty  
one years from the first day of November and we do further Certify that the Average  
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in said County of Clare for the  
Period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1828 is fifteen Shillings  
and two pence farthing Sterling per Bussel Dated this 30<sup>th</sup> day of October 1827
