I Walter Thomas Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of King William the fourth, entitled "an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, to make such Compositions permanent, to ascertain and fix a Just and true Composition for all Tithes arising growing, yielding or payable within the Parish of (O'Dorney and County of Kerry), do hereby certify that the true and Just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever, within the Tithable part of said Parish is One hundred and Eighty four Pounds Sterling by the year, of which sum of One hundred and Eighty four Pounds the sum of Eighty six Pounds Sterling is due and payable to Thomas Steer being his proportion as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Lessee of the Earl of Cork, and at the expiration of the said Lease, to said Earl of Cork as lay impropriator the sum of Eighty four Pounds is due and payable to John Doolin being his proportion as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Lessee of the late Lord Glendoe, and at the expiration of said Lease to William Crosbie Esq. as the Representative of said Lord Glendoe, as lay impropriator, and the sum of Forty five Pounds Sterling are due and payable to George Lawlor, and Mary Lawlor, being their proportion as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by them as joint Lessees of said Lord Glendoe and at the expiration of said Lease to said William Crosbie Esq. as the Representative of said Lord Glendoe, as lay impropriator of said Parish, and I do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty is one Pound twelve shillings and ten pence halfpenny Sterling per Bushel, and that the average Price of Oats being also principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty is thirteen shillings and three pence three farthings
