

Two pence three farthings, is due and payable
to the Rev Francis Lygon as a composition
for the tythe claimable by him as Rector
of the said Parish, the sum of £58-3-0 is due
and payable to the Rev W^m Dodson as a composition
for the tythe claimable by him as Vicar of said
Parish, and the sum of £38-15-1/2 is due and
payable to the Dean and Chapter for the use
of the Economy of Killaloe, and we do further
certify that the average price of oats being
the corn principally grown in such County, for
the period of seven years ending the 1st day of November
1821 was fourteen shillings and one farthing per
barrill as taken from the Dublin gazette —
