We Jeffrey French and Arthur Morone Esqrs. Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth entitled an act to provide for the establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, as also by virtue of an act passed in the fifth year of the reign of King George the fourth entitled an act to amend an act of the last Session of Parliament for providing for the establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable within the Parish of Elphin in the County of Roscommon do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two Hundred and Forty-two pounds one shilling and eight pence yearly which sum of Two Hundred and Forty-two pounds one shilling and eight pence yearly is due and payable to the Very Rev^d the Dean of Elphin as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish and to be continued invariable for twenty one years from the first of November 1825 And we do further certify that the average prices of Oats being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 is nine shillings and six pence per barrel
