I George Rowan do swear that I will faithfully, impartially and honestly according to the best of my skill and ability execute and perform the powers and authorities, vested and reposed in me as Commissioner in the Parish of O'Brenan by virtue of an Act passed in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth entitled an act to provide for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, according to the directions of the said Act, and according to equity and good conscience, and without favour or affection, prejudice or malice to any person or persons whomsoever. So. help me God.

We George Rowan and Francis Walker Esqrs. Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising, growing yielded or payable within the said Parish of O'Brenan in the County of Kerry, DO CERTIFY hereby, that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Seventy four pounds eleven shillings sterling by the year which sum of seventy four pounds eleven shillings sterling is due and payable to the Revd. John Kerin, as a composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector of said Parish.

And WE DO further certify that the average price of Oats, being the corn principally grown, for the period of seven years ending the first day of November 1821 - was fifteen shillings and two pence per barrell of fourteen stone - Dated this 28th day of March 1825.
