

And sworn, under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year
of the reign of King George the Fourth to ascertain & fix a true & just com-
-position for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the said
Parish of Penan in the County of Mayo. Do certify hereby, that the true & just
amount of composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish, is
Sixty four pounds eleven shillings sterling by the year, which sum of Sixty four
pounds eleven shillings $\frac{11}{16}$ is due & payable to the Rev^d John Nevin, as
a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of said Parish—

And We Do further certify that the average price of Oats, being the
Corn principally grown in the period of seven years ending the first day
of Nov^r 1821, was fifteen shillings & two pence $\frac{1}{2}$ per Bushel of fourteen Stone.
