

*Tithe Composition*  
*Parish of Old Connell*

I John Symes having been duly appointed and Sworn as Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act, made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, intituled, "an Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" And by Virtue of an Act passed in the Second and Third Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled "an Act to amend Three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eight Years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, and to ascertain and fix a True, and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing yielded or payable within the parish of Old Connell, Barony of Old Connell and County of Kildare, Do hereby Certify That the True and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish, is One Hundred and Forty pounds, Sterling, and which said Sum of One Hundred and Forty pounds, is due by the Year and payable to the Reverend Francis Langford Rector of said Parish.

And I further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven Years ending the first day of November 1830. is Thirty Two Shillings and One Shilling by the Barrel.
