

A Book of the Assessment, Appraisal and Valuation of the Cliffland
Townlands in the Parish of Old Ross, in the Union of St. Mary,
New Ross in the Diocese of Ferns and County of Wexford,
made by us Commissioners ^{of the said} under the latter Composition Act,
for the said Parish.

The Rector's Annual Income out of the said Parish
is Five Hundred and Sixty five Pounds Seventeen Shillings and
Six Pence, Irish being Two Hundred and Twenty two Pounds
Ten Shillings and Seven pence Sterling, British Currency.
There is neither Glebe land, nor Land tithe for in the Parish. It contains
6790.2 Irish plantation Measure, and has 321 different
and separate Holdings.

The Rates of Valuation are First Quality Three Shillings, 2^d Two Shillings
and Six pence, Third One Shilling and Fourth Quality Six pence
per Acre - Irish.
