

We Rev^d Thomas Walker and Alex^r Clendinning
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by
virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of
King George the fourth entitled an act to provide for the
Establishing of composition for Tithes in Ireland for
a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded
or payable within the Parish of Cliffhauwell in the County
of Mayo do hereby certify that the true and just amount
of composition for all Tithes whatever within the
said Parish is Three hundred pounds Sterling
by the Year of which Sum of Three Hundred pounds
Sterling. The Sum of Two Hundred Twenty five pounds
is due & payable to the Venerable Archdeacon Grace as composition
for the Tithes claimable by him as vicar of said Parish. The Sum
of Sixty pounds is due and payable to the Venerable Archdeacon
Harbottle as composition for the Tithes claimable by him as owner
of the Rectorial Tithes of said Parish. The Sum of Fifteen
pounds is due & payable to the Rev^d Geo^r Purvis as composition
for the Tithes claimable by him as patron of any of the parishes of
Kilbegg within said Parish

And we do further certify that the average price of
Oats being the corn principally grown in such county
for the period of seven years ending on the First of
November 1821 (one is L^o. 15.. 2 per Barrel
