

We the undersigned Joseph Bradshaw and John Ryan Commissioners
appointed under the Tythe Composition acts, find the Parish of Miltor
sit the Barony of Coonagh & County of Simerick, to contain by our survey
and valuation thereof Four thousand one hundred & Sixty acres, two roods
and twenty five perches Irish plantation measure, of which we find
that two thousand two hundred and Fifty seven acres, three roods, and
twelve perches, marked first class or quality are worth two guineas per
acre shall pay the sum of one shilling late Irish currency per
acre and so in proportion for roods and perches, as a composition for
the Tythes thereof, And we find that one thousand two hundred and
thirty acres one rood and thirty seven perches marked second class or quality,
are worth one guinea and half per acre shall pay the sum of
ten pence late Irish currency per acre and so in proportion for roods
and perches as a composition for the Tythes thereof, and we find
that five hundred and six acres two roods and one perch marked
third class or quality are worth one guinea per acre shall pay the
sum of eight pence farthing per acre and so in proportion for
roods and perches as a composition for the Tythes thereof, And we
find that one hundred and fifteen acres, three roods and twenty seven
perches are worth the sum of sixteen shillings per acre shall pay
