One Hundred and eighty two pounds, eighteen shillings, and
Six pence halfpenny late Irish currency being the sum
agreed on as a Composition for the incumbents part of the
Tythes of said Parish, all the above mentioned sums are in
the late Irish currency, and the Survey's made in the
Irish Plantation measure,
