We Augustus Moran and Samuel Jackson Cassidy Gentle-  
men Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under and by  
virtue of an Act made in the fourth Year of the Reign of  
King George the fourth intituled "An act to provide for  
the Establishment of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland for  
a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Compo-  
sition for all Tythes, arising, growing, yielded or payable  
within the Parish of Oughmanna in the county of Clare. do  
hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition  
for all Tythes whatever within the said Parish is One Hundred  
and Twenty pounds sterl by the year, of which sum of One  
Hundred and Twenty pounds, the whole is due and  
payable to the Revd. Mark Cassidy as a Composition for  
the Tythes claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the said  
Parish. and we do further Certify that the Average price of wheat  
being the corn principally grown in said County, for the period  
of Seven years ending on this thirtieth day of October One  
Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Eight is Twenty  
five Shillings sterl per Barrel of Twenty stone.
