John Walsh and Henry Harrison Clarke Commissions
solely appointed and sworn under and by virtue of
an Act made in the year of the reign of King George the
fourth intituled "an Act to provide for the establishment
of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited
time" to ascertain and pay a true and just com-
pensation for all tithes, arising, growing, yielded
and payable within the Parish of Dorridge in the
County of Wicklow, do hereby certify that the true
and just amount of compensation for all tithes
within the said Parish that are due
and payable to the Revd William Guyer
as a compensation for the tithes claimable by
him as incumbent of the said Parish of Dorridge
has been agreed on between the said incumbent
and the parishioners of said Parish to be one
hundred and eighty pounds by the year
which sum includes one third of the tithes of
the townland of Garinacuph, the remaining
two thirds of the tithes of said townland being
due and payable to the Mayor of St. Andrew
Which entire sum of One hundred and eighty pounds
is due and payable to the said Revd William Guyer
as a compensation for the tithes claimable by him
as incumbent of the said Parish of Dorridge
