 of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
 the said Parish is Three hundred pounds by
 the Year, the whole of which Sum is due and
 payable to the Rev^d Gen^l Prabagan as a
 Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as
 Rector Incumbent of said Parish, to remain
 invariable for the term of twenty one years
 from the first day of May next ensuing
~~from~~ the date thereof, and we further Certify
 that the average price of Oats, being the
 Corn principally grown in such County for the
 period of Seven Years ending on the first day
 of Nov^r: One thousand eight hundred and twenty
 One is fifteen Shillings and two pence ~~four~~
 farthings ~~of~~ ^{per} Bushel.
