

We Bryan Conagher and William O'Hea Commissioners  
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an  
Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George  
the fourth entitled "An Act to provide for the establishing  
of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" do  
hereby certify that at a Special Vestry held according to  
the provisions of said Act in the Parish Church of the  
Union of Charlestown exclusively for the Parish of Philipps  
-town in said Union on Thursday the 27<sup>th</sup> Inst it was  
then and there agreed upon and confirmed (the consent  
of his Grace the Lord Primate having been previously  
obtained) between the Rector of said Parish and the Parish  
-ioners then assembled that the fixed yearly sum of  
Three Hundred and Forty five pounds Sterling  
be the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes  
arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish  
of Philipps Town in said Union of Charlestown in the  
County of Louth and it was further agreed upon that such  
composition shall be inviolable for the term of Twenty one  
years from the first day of November next ensuing the date  
hereof and that such composition shall continue to be levied  
for such term of Twenty one years and shall not be subject  
to any variation in the amount thereof during such period  
of twenty one years under the provisions of said limited Act  
or this Act whatever the price of corn may be
