I James Gorman duly appointed and sworn

King George the Fourth, provided for establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make
such Compositions permanent to ascertain and
fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising
growing yielding or payable within the Parish of
Loburn

in the County of Kilkenny do hereby certify that
the true and just amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatever within the said parish is Three

Shillings per Annis by the year of which sum of
Three Shillings per Annis are Shillings and Sixpence
