Warrant

Whereas by an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd years of
the reign of His present Majesty King William the
Fourth, Entitled 'An Act to amend Three Acts passed
respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the seventh
and Eighth Years, of the reign of His late Majesty
King George the Fourth, providing for the Establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland; and to make
such Compositions permanent.

It is amongst other Things enacted that in
and for every parish or parts of a parish in Ireland
wherein a Composition for the Tithes thereof shall
not have been made under the said recited Acts
with the several persons entitled to Tithes therein
within Three months after the passing of the
said Act. It shall and may be lawful for The Lord
Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of
Ireland when and as he or they shall so think fit
to nominate some person to be a Commissioner for
carrying the said Act of 2nd and 3rd Years of King
William the Fourth and the Acts therein recited
