and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second
and third Years of the Reign of King William the Fourth entitled
an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth and
fifth and seventh and eight years of the Reign of his late Majesty
King George the fourth Providing for the establishing of
Compositions of Tithes in Ireland and so to make such Compositions
permanent to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the
Parish of Portoban alias Portanus in the Diocess and in
the County of Dublin Do hereby Certify that the true and
just Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said
Parish is One Hundred and thirty seven pounds seven shillings

and seven pence three farthings of which sum of One Hundred
£ 137 7 7 ³/₄ = Total Comp
and thirty seven pounds seven shillings and seven pence three

farthings One Hundred and seven pounds three shillings and
£ 107 3 9 = Lay Com
and nine pence is due and payable to Mary Missett Spinster

as Lay Impropriator and the sum of thirty pounds three shillings
£ 30 3 10 ³/₄ = Eccl
and ten pence three farthings is due and payable to the Rev^d William

Hamilton as Incumbent and Owner of the Vicarial Tithes of the Parish

And I further Certify that the average price of Oats
being the Crop principally grown in such Parish for the Period
of seven years ending the first day of November 1830 is Twelve shillings
and eleven pence half penny and of Wheat for the same period One
Pound Twelve shillings and one half penny by the Barrel stated
this Thirtieth day of January 1834
