Lessee of the Rectorial Tithes thereof - under the Provisions of the Acts of the 2^d & 3^d William the Fourth entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 2^d 5th & in the 7th & 8th years of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing a Composition for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Composition permanent -
