I James Gorman Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King William the Fourth intituled an act to amend three acts respectively passed in the Fourth Fifth and in the Seventh and Eight years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, provided for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such compositions permanent to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding or payable within the Parish of Lottuscolly in the County of Kilkenny do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two Hundred Pounds Sterls by the year of which sum of Two Hundred Pounds Twenty six Pounds
