Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to as-
-certain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes
arising, growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Pinn
in the County of Kerry do hereby Certify that the true and
just amount of composition for all Tithes whatsoever within
the said Parish is One hundred and Forty pounds Three
Shillings and four pence Sterling by the year the whole
of which Sum is due and payable to the Rev. Dan. Lucas
as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector
and Vicar of the said Parish for the term of Twentyone
years from the date hereof -

And we do further certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in
such County for the period of Seven years ending
the 1st day of November 1821. is fourteen Shillings
a Barrel given under our hands this 19th day
of April 1825 -
