

W^{ch} Charles Fitzgerald and Daniel McMahon Commissioners appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, Intituled "An Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time," to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable, within the Parish of Linn in the County of Clare, Do hereby Certify that the sum of Twenty five pounds are due and payable by the year to the M^{rs} Michael Brew in the said parish of Linn, as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him in the said parish of Linn, as Prebendary of Tullob, And that such Compositions shall continue to be levied for such Term of Twenty one Years, and shall not be subject to any Variation in the Amount thereof during said Twenty One Years under the provisions of said Act or Acts whatever. The price of Corn may be given under our hands this 23 Day of April 1826
