

Dennis Kelly and Sam W. Kelly, Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an
Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King
George the fourth, entitled an Act to provide for the
establishing of Compositions for Tithe in Ireland for a
limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just Compo-
sition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable
within the parish of Cahara in the County of Roscommon
do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Com-
position for all Tithes whatsoever, in the said Parish is
one hundred and sixteen pounds British Currency
by the year, of which sum of one hundred and sixteen pounds
one half is due and payable to the Rev. Owen Gallaher as
a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Vicar
of the said Parish, namely the sum of fifty eight pounds.
And the sum of fifty eight pounds being also one half to
the Incorporated Society as a composition for Tithe
claimable by them

And we do further certify that the average price of oats
being the corn principally grown in such County, for the period
of seven years ending on the first of Nov^r 1821, is ten shillings
and six pence late Currency.
