hereby certify that the true and just amount of Compo-
-sition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is
~~One hundred and forty two Pounds 3/6~~

by the year. Of which sum of One hundred forty two Pounds 3/6
the whole is due & payable to the Rev^d Eric Davis as a
Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector
of the said Parish.

And we do further certify that the average price of Wheat
being the Corn principally grown in such County for the
period of Seven years ending on the 1st day of November
1821. is One Pound eighteen shillings & eight pence half penny
per Barrel. and that the average price of Oats for the same
period of Seven years is Fifteen shillings & two pence farthing.
per Barrel.
