

Extracted from the Vestry Book of the Parish of Raheny.

At a Vestry duly called and held in the Parish Church of Raheny on Thursday the 18<sup>th</sup> of September 1828 under the Tithes Composition Act. Resolved. That the sum of five Shillings & six pence of Irish acre be agreed to on the part of the Parish for the term of 21 years invariably.

At an adjourned Vestry held this day it was resolved that John Ball Esq<sup>r</sup> be appointed Commissioner on the part of the Parish and Charles Davis Esq<sup>r</sup> on the part of the Rector. the latter subject to the approval of the Arch-Bishop.
