

We the Rev^d Melton Gifford and William Jefford Jun^r Esq^s of Greenville
 Commissioners duly appointed and sworn by virtue of An Act made in the
 fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth Entituled An Act to
 provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
 time; also of an Act made in the fifth year of the Reign of George the fourth
 Entituled An Act to amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament to
 provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, to ascertain
 and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes, arising, growing, yielded
 & payable within the Parish of Nahan in the Kings County. Do hereby
 Certify, that an Agreement has been entered into on the part of the
 Marquess of Downshire and the Marchioness of Downshire by their Agent
 Thomas Murray Esq^r to accept the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds
 by the year for twenty one years, as a Composition for the Rectorial Tithes
 claimable by them from the said Parish of Nahan and by the Rev^d
 Thomas Kemmis Vicar of the Union of Inceall to accept of the sum of
 seventy seven pounds eight shillings and nine pence by the year for
 twenty one years, as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as
 Vicar of said Union of Inceall from said Parish of Nahan - We
 therefore hereby further Certify that the true and just amount of
 Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish of Nahan
 is two hundred and twenty seven pounds eight shillings and nine
 pence by the year - Of which sum of two hundred and twenty seven
 pounds eight shillings and nine pence about two third parts
 amounting to one hundred and fifty pounds are due and
 payable to the Marquess of Downshire and the Marchioness of
 Downshire as Lay Impropriators and about one third amounting
 to seventy seven pounds eight shillings and nine pence is
 due and payable to the Rev^d Thomas Kemmis as Vicar
 of said Union of Inceall
