

I James French Commissioner, duly appointed
and sworn, under and by virtue of an act passed in
the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth,
Entituled an act to provide for the Establishing of
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
time, and by virtue of an act passed in the second
and third years of the Reign of his Majesty King
William the Fourth, Entituled an act to amend
three acts pass respectively, in the Fourth, Fifth,
and in the Seventh, and Eighth years of the Reign
of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, provi-
ding for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes
in Ireland, and to make such Compositions per-
manent, and to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded,
or payable within the Parish of Rahoon in the
county of Galway, do hereby Certify that the true and
just composition for all Tithes whatever, within the
said Parish, is one hundred and Fifty six pounds
Two Shillings Sterling by the year, of which sum
of One hundred and Fifty six pounds two Shillings,
Three fourth parts, are due and payable to the
Very Reverend James Daly as a Composition for
Tithe Claimable by him as Warden, and Owner,
of the Collegiate Tithes of said Parish, and one
Fourth part of said sum of one hundred and Fifty six
pounds two Shillings are due and payable to the
Reverend John Wilson claimable by him as
perpetual Curate of said Parish,
