

We the Rev^d Melton Giffen and William Baynall Commissioners
 duly appointed and sworn by virtue of an Act made in the fourth
 year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled An Act to
 provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
 for a limited time, also of an Act made in the fifth year of the
 Reign of King George the Fourth entitled An Act to amend an
 Act of the last Session of Parliament to provide for the Establishing
 of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, to ascertain and fix a true
 and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded,
 or payable within the Parish of Nabue in the County of West-
 Meath, (being part of the Union of Ardaraheen) Do hereby Certify
 that An Agreement bearing date the sixth day of September
 1825 has been entered into on the part of the Marquess and
Marchioness of Downshire by their Agent Thomas Murray
 Esq^r to accept of the sum of seventy Pounds by the year for
 twenty one years as a Composition for the Rectorial Tithes
 claimable by them from the said Parish of Nabue, and that
 An Agreement bearing date the second day of December
 1824 has been entered into by the Rev^d George Leslie Giffen Vicar
 of said Union of Ardaraheen to accept of the sum of Forty Pounds
 by the year for twenty one years as a Composition for the Vicarial
 Tithes claimable by him from the said Parish of Nabue. We
 therefore hereby further Certify that the true and just amount of
 Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish of Nabue
 is one hundred and ten pounds by the year. Of which sum of
 one hundred and ten pounds about two third parts amounting
 to seventy ~~xxx~~ pounds are due and payable to the Marquess of
 Downshire and the Marchioness of Downshire as Lay Impropri-
 etors and about one third amounting to forty pounds is due and
 payable to the Rev^d George Leslie Giffen as Vicar of said Union
 of Ardaraheen.
