by him as Rector of said Parish -

And we do further certify that the average price of  
Oats, being the Corn principally grown in said County  
for the Period of seven years ending the first day of  
Nov<sup>r</sup> 1821 - was fifteen shillings and Two pence for Barrel  
of Fourteen Stone -
