appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made
in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the
fourth intituled an Act to provide for the Establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time
to ascertain and fix a true and Just Composition for
all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or pay-able,
within the Parish of Rathasbuck in the Queen's County
do hereby Certify that the true and Just amount of
Composition for all Tithes within the said
Parish is Three hundred and Twenty five pounds by the
year - Which sum of Three hundred and Twenty five pounds
are due and payable to the Reverend John Preston
as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as

Rector of the said Parish - And we do further Certify
that the average price of Oats being the Com principally
grown in such County for the Period of seven years ending
the 1st day of November 1821 is fifteen Shillings and two
pence per barrel - Dated this 28th day of February 1825
