of Ross within the said parish.

And I do further certify that the average  
price of wheat, being the best price paid for grain in  
such County for the period of seven years ending on  
the first day of November 1830 thirty is one pound  
seven shillings and one halfpenny per four barrel  
as published in the Dublin Gazette.
