Warren Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Rathbragh in the County of Wicklow. do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two Hundred and Fifteen Pounds Sterling — British by the year which Sum of Two Hundred and Fifteen Pounds is due and payable to the Rev. Luke Fowler Rector of said Parish as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish. and we do further certify that the Average price of wheat being the <sup>corn</sup> principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first Day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred and twenty One is One Pound fifteen Shillings and eight pence three farthings British per Bush Dated this 28<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1826 Six
