true and just Amount of Compositions for all the Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is Three hundred and ten Pounds Sterling
payable by the Year and of which Sum of Three hundred and ten Pounds
Sterling the Sum of Two hundred and fifty Pounds Sterling is payable
by the Year to the Reverend Thomas Hayden Incumbent of said Parish
and the Sum of Sixty Pounds Sterling is payable by the Year
to the Very Reverend the Dean of Saint Patrick's Dublin

And we do further certify that the Average price
of Wheat is $\text{£}11-18-8\frac{1}{4}$ per Barrel and that Average price
of Oats is $\text{£}0-15-2\frac{1}{4}$ per Barrel for the seven Years ending ~~1821~~
the first of November 1821
