Composition for all Tithes Arising from any yielding or
Payable within the Parish of Rathcooney in the County of
the City of Cork. Do hereby Certify that the true and
just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever
within the said Parish is Five Hundred pounds
Sterling by the year Payable to the Reverend William
Lewis Beauport Preb. and Rector of said Parish
pursuant to an agreement entered into by the said
William Lewis Beauport and a Special Vestry of
said Parish. And We do further Certify that the cur-
rent price of oats being the Corn principally grown in
said County for the period of seven years ending the
first day of November one thousand eight hundred and
twenty one is fifteen shillings and two pence farthings
currency (or fourteen shillings British currency) per Barrel
Dated this twenty ~~fourth~~ third day
of August one thousand eight hundred and twenty
two
