

At a Special Vestry duly held in the Parish Church of Rathcoony
in the Diocesis of Cork on the 11th day of September 1826 for the
purpose of considering the foregoing Certificate made and signed
by Thomas Martin and John Whelan duly appointed Com-
missioners to fix and ascertain a Composition for all the Tithes
of the said Parish under the provisions of an Act made in
the Seventh year of the reign of King George the Fourth intitled
"an Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes
in Ireland for a limited time" and also of an Amendment
of the same Act made in the Fifth year of King George the
Fourth -

Now be it shewed that the Special Vestry here in said Vestry assembled
having duly considered the said Certificate do hereby approve
of and finally confirm the said Certificate and do also
hereby further agree that the sum of Five hundred Pounds
Sterling by the year fixed and ascertained in said Certificate
as the am^t of Composition for all the Tithes in said Parish shall
be paid to the Rectors the Rev^d William L. Beaumont of said
Parish or the Successor or Successors according to the Act - dated
the 11th day of September 1826 viz -
