The true and just Amount of Compositions
for all Tithes whatever within the Town
Lands of Macetown Moygallen Clonsheaven
and Rathconnel in the said Parish of Rathcon-
-nel is Seventy eight Pounds twelve Shillings

It by the year of which Sum the whole is
payable to the Vicar of the said Parish, ^{as Com-}
-position for the Tithes claimable by him as
Vicar of the said Parish, ^{out of said town lands} and we do further Certify

that the true and just Amount of Compositions
for the remaining part of the vicarial tithes
arising out of the remaining townlands of
said Parish is the Sum of one hundred and
twenty one pounds eight Shillings Sterling by
the year of which Sum of one hundred and
