 and Ninety three Pounds ten shillings by the year of which sum
 of Three Hundred and Ninety three Pounds ten shillings two
 third parts are due & payable to Richard Armstrong, son of
 Charles Armstrong Esq. and Richard Armstrong Smith as a
 Composition for the Tithes claimable by them as Lay Propri-
 etors of the said Parish, and one third part is due and
 payable to the Rev. James, and the Vicar of the said
 Parish -

And I do further Certify that
 the average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown
 in this County for the period of seven years ending on
 the 1st day of November 1830 is twelve shillings and
 seven pence half penny of Ireland -
