

Certificate of Tithe Composition

I Nicholas Bird Jago of Millromney  
in the County of Cork Commissioner duly appointed and sworn  
under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third  
years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth  
entitled "An Act to amend three acts passed respectively in  
"the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign  
"of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for  
"the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to  
"make such Compositions permanent" — to ascertain  
and find a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising  
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Rathelarn  
in the County of Cork — do hereby Certify, that the true  
and just amount of Compositions for all Tithes whatever  
within the said Parish is Six Hundred and Fifty  
pounds per Annum by the year —

And that the whole of the said Sum is due and payable  
to the Reverend Thomas Waggott as Rector of the said Parish

And I do further Certify that the Average price of Wheat  
being the Corn principally grown in said County for the  
period of seven years ending the first day of November in the  
year 1830 Thirty — is One pound twelve Shillings and one  
half penny per Barrel —
