in the County of Cork - Commissioner

duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act  
made in the Second and Third years of the Reign of his  
Majesty King William the Fourth - entitled "An Act to  
"amend Three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth,  
"and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his  
"late Majesty King George the Fourth - providing for  
"the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and  
"to make such Compositions permanent" - to ascertain  
and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes -  
arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish  
of Rathclarin in the County of Cork - do hereby Certify  
that the true and just amount of Composition for all  
Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Six Hundred  
and Fifty pounds Sterling by the year

and that the whole of the said sum is due and payable  
to the Reverend Thomas Waggott as Rector of the said Parish

And I do further Certify that the Average price of wheat  
being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period  
of seven years ending the first day of November in the year  
1830 Thirty is one pound Twelve Shillings and One half penny  
per Barrel - Given under my hand this 31<sup>st</sup> day of  
October 1833 Thirty-three -
