

By the Justices assigned to keep the Peace in and for  
the County of Cork at a general quarter Sessions for  
the peace holden at <sup>for the Division of Bandon:</sup> Bandon in Cork County West  
Riding on the twenty fourth day of October One thousand  
eight hundred and fifty four

Whereas due notice of application having been first affixed  
at the times and in the manner directed by the statutes in  
such case made and provided by John Bowen William  
Scott and Richard Dealy Esquires three persons owners of land  
in the Parish of Rathclarin Diocese of Cork and Ross  
Division of Bandon and Cork County West riding each  
charged with the annual payment of the sum of Three pounds  
and upwards in respect of the rent charged payable in lieu  
of the composition for Tithes within said Parish made by  
the Certificate of Nicholas B. Jagoe bearing date the Thirtieth  
first day of October one thousand eight hundred and thirty  
three in pursuance of the statute in such case made and  
provided by which certificate the gross amount of composition  
for all Tithes whatsoever in the said Parish was certified  
to be the annual sum of Six hundred and fifty pounds  
the said three owners of land made application in  
writing to the Justices of the Peace at Quarter Sessions  
above mentioned to have the average price of good and  
Marketable Wheat being the grain in the certificate mentioned  
for the preceding Seven Years in the statutes in that behalf  
mentioned enquired of and ascertained in order that  
the said Composition for Tithes and the rent charged in  
lieu of such composition might be diminished according  
to such average price as compared with the price of One  
pound twelve Shillings and a half penny being the price of  
Wheat as set forth in the said Certificate And whereas  
the said applicants and the Reverend Thomas Waggett  
the Ecclesiastical Incumbent of said Parish having  
appeared before the <sup>Justices at</sup> said Quarter Sessions by their  
Counsel or Agents and the said Notice of application  
and the average price of wheat as advertized in the Dublin  
Gazette
