establishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time &
ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising
growing and yielded and payable within the Parish of Rathenee in the

Co^y of Meath do hereby certify that the true and just composition for all
Tithes whatsoever within the S^d Parish is Eight hundred and seventy
five Pounds. Irish currency being Eight hundred and seven pounds
thirteen Shillings and ten pence $\frac{1}{4}$ British currency by the year of which
sum of Eight hundred and seventy five pounds - four hundred and
seventy five pounds Irish currency is due and payable to William Allen Esq
as Vicar of the Rectorial tithes of the S^d Parish as a composition for all tithes
claimable by him from the S^d Parish and the sum of four hundred Pounds
Irish currency is due and payable to the Rev^d Richard Ryan as vicar of
S^d Parish in lieu of all tithes claimable by him and we do further certify
that the average price of wheat for the period of seven years ending the
first day of November 1821. or - is 1-18-8 $\frac{1}{2}$ M^{rs} Bonell and the
average price of Oats for S^d Parish is 15-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ M^{rs} Bonell.
