

And Estimate or Valuation and Map to be made of all the Lands and Grounds in the said Parish, by a Competent and experienced Surveyor and Valuer of Lands, and having on the 21st day of May 1825, given notice in Writing to the Churchwardens and to the Ecclesiastical Incumbent of said Parish that said Survey, Measurement and Estimate or Valuation and Map, had been deposited by us, with Mr. James Byrnes of Millbrook in said Parish, for the Inspection of all Persons interested in the Lands or Tithes of said Parish, and that we would attend at the Parish Church of said Parish, in Rathfriland on Monday the 20th day of June, then next, to hear objections from such Persons as should be dissatisfied with said Survey, Measurement, Estimate, Valuation or Map or any of them, and which was promulgated by the said Churchwardens, to the Parishioners, and we having attended accordingly at the time and place aforesaid, and at an adjournment on the 27th of same Month, and having heard and determined, all and every of the objections of the several and respective Land holders, who then and there attended, and having caused the said Survey, Measurement, Estimate, Valuation and Map, to be altered accordingly, and having finally, approved of and confirmed the same do hereby Certify that we have faithfully, impartially and Honestly, according to the best of our skill and Ability, and according to equity and good conscience, and without favor or affection, prejudice or Malice to any person or persons whatsoever made the foregoing Assessment and Apportionment of the Tithe Composition upon all Lands within said Parish not being Tithe-free, equally in proportion and according to the true Annual Value of the several Lands - Given under our hands this 21st day of July 1825.
