King George the Fourth entitled "An Act to pro-  
vide for the Establishing of Compositions for  
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time," to ascer-  
tain & fix a true & just Composition for all  
Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable  
within the Parish of Rathfife in the County  
of Meath. Do hereby certify that the true, and  
just Amount of Compositions for all Tithes what-  
soever within the said Parish is One Hun-  
dred & Eighty Pounds by the Year, of which  
Sum of One Hundred & Eighty Pounds the  
whole is due & payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Stephen  
Radcliff as a Composition for the Tithes  
claimable by him as Rector of the said  
Parish. And we further certify that  
the Average price of Wheat, being the Corn prin-  
cipally grown in such County for the period  
of seven years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Novem-  
ber 1821 is One pound Eighteen Shillings &  
Eight pence half penny p<sup>r</sup>. Barrel estimated ac-  
cording to the late Currency of Ireland.
