an act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of
King George the Fourth entitled "An act to
provide for the establishing of compositions for
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time", to ascer-
tain and fix a true and just Composition for
all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable
within the Parish of Rathfrigh in the County of Meath,
do hereby Certify that the true, and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the
said Parish is One Hundred and Eighty Pounds
by the Year, of which sum of One Hundred and
Eighty Pounds the whole is due and payable to
the Rev^d Stephen Radcliff as a composition for
the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the
said Parish. — And we do further Certify
that the average price of Wheat, being the
Corn principally grown in such County for
the period of Seven Years ending on the 1st day
of November 1821 is One Pound Eighteen Shillings
and Eight pence halfpenny for Barrell etc.
"mated according to the late currency of
Ireland"
